AP Publications Assistance Fund

This fund, new for academic year '06-'07, is aimed at assisting young scholars who have been accepted for publication in a scholarly journal, but who need assistance with funding to help cover costs of images and rights for the publication.

CONDITIONS:

1. This is meant for advanced-level doctoral students and doctoral alums who have graduated within the past five years.
2. The proposal for aid consideration must be for a publication in a non-profit/scholarly journal that does not cover such costs, and where the student is not receiving a stipend for the article.
3. The BGC will not in any way be responsible for securing or clearing rights to any images, nor will it be accountable for any mis-use of the copyright regulations. The BGC will merely provide a small award, which will become available for the young scholar's use. All responsibility for images will remain with the student, and awardees must sign an agreement about this on conferral of the grant.
4. A doctoral candidate may apply for this grant more than once, but not more than once in a calendar year.
5. The BGC must receive a copy of the published article for the Library.
6. Receipts for the total of the grant must be submitted within the same calendar year in which the award is granted. Late submission of receipts makes the grant subject to reporting as taxable income, and will preclude the student from further funding applications at the BGC.
7. Student must be in good standing, and must have completed all coursework and language requirements for the doctoral degree.

PROCEDURE:

1. Fill out the attached form, including a description of your piece/project, and identification of the journal and the proposed publication date.
2. Include a copy of the letter of acceptance of your article.
3. Submit an updated CV.
4. The application is due at the time of the regularly scheduled travel and research committee review. (In fall of 2006 that date is Oct. 20th; in spring of 2007, the deadline is March 2nd.)

- I. Please tell us about your proposal, including the Journal in which it will appear, the probable publication date, etc. (You may attach no more than one page to this application.)
- II. On a second sheet, please outline your estimated total cost for Images/rights, and the amount you are asking for from the fund. (Please remember these will be modest awards).
- III. Please also sign and submit the waiver form indicating that you understand that the BGC is in no way responsible or liable for either obtaining these images for you, or clearing rights for them. This will be entirely your responsibility.
- IV. These materials are due, (5 full sets) in the AP office by Oct.20th for fall consideration, and March 2nd for spring.
- V. When the article is published, submit a copy of the Journal to AP.

WAIVER AGREEMENT

This must be submitted with your application, and goes into effect should you be awarded a grant.
